CHAIRSIDE INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Clean and roughen denture area to be relined. Dry denture completely.
- 2. Lubricate the labial and buccal surfaces within 1/8" of the peripheral border.
- Paint reline area with DuraBase Repair Liquid. This assures a chemical bond.
- Recommended powder/liquid proportions: Powder 10 ml - shorter plastic vial Liquid 5 ml - taller plastic vial

Add liquid to powder in mixing cup and stir thoroughly for 30 seconds.

- 5. Wait approximately 1 to 3 minutes and apply mixture to denture.
- 6. Insert denture in mouth and have patient close mouth lightly into occlusion.
- 7. After approximately 3–4 minutes in the mouth, muscle-trim the borders, then remove the denture and trim the excess. Rinse the denture in cold tap water and reseat in the patient's mouth. Remove and let cure on bench.
- 8. DuraBase sets in approximately 15 minutes after curing. Trim any excess material and polish denture.
- To reduce residual taste, place denture in hot water for 10 minutes at 130° F / 55° C or in a pressure cooker at 130° F / 55° C for 10 minutes at 15 psi.
