

Serrated so DuraLay will readily adhere
Tapered for easy insertion into canal
Complete burnout with DuraLay Resin,
leaving no residue



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Prepare canal to desired length and size.
- 2. Lubricate the canal with DuraLay Lubricant or mineral oil.
- Make a mix of DuraLay and apply it into the canal or use the brush technique and paint DuraLay into the canal.
- 4. Dip the DuraLay pin into the DuraLay Liquid, then add DuraLay onto the pin using the brush technique.
- 5. Insert into the canal and remove excess DuraLay. DuraLay will set up completely in about 5 minutes. Before it is set up, (approximately 4 minutes) remove pattern and reinsert into the canal. This will facilitate the final removal of the pattern if undercuts are present.
- 6. Sprue and cast.
